Dear Friends,

I would like to take this opportunity to say thank you for your involvement with Siloam through your prayers, financial support and your "hands on" in missions. We are excited at what God has done and continues to do here in Snow Camp. He has truly blessed Siloam and I believe it is in part because of our transparency in ministry, keeping a tight budget and being good financial stewards of God's money. Last year, we were able to provide housing for **21 missionary families** and gave away thousands of dollars worth of donated food and clothing. We also had volunteers who gave hundreds of hours to help with various projects around the property.

My life verse is Proverbs 3:5-6, "*Trust in the Lord with all thine heart and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge Him and He shall direct your paths.*" 2010 was a very challenging year for Siloam financially and many times we found ourselves overwhelmed. But, this verse has been a constant reminder of God's faithfulness and our need to just let go and let Him take care of us each day as we continue to serve Him and the missionary families He sends to us.

As the year came to a close, God gave us the miracle of allowing us to end the year in the black, as you see by the enclosed 2010 financial statement! What a faithful God we serve!

With 2010 behind us, we continue to look *ahead* to what God has for us in 2011. There are two major projects that we are asking the Lord to help us complete *as funds become available*. Project #1, is to finish construction of the Bill and Sandra Rice missionary home. We have been waiting on the weather to clear up here in order to put the second floor on and finish the roof trusses and then finish enclosing the exterior. So far, we have had \$25,482.24 designated for this project, which is enough to get the second floor and trusses completed. We are waiting for God's supply to continue with and finish construction.

Project #2 is to renovate our old tractor shed into a game room for the missionary kids. We estimate that this project will cost \$15,000.00. This will give the families a place to play ping pong, air hockey and use the exercise equipment that has been donated to Siloam.

Please pray about how God might use you to help us with these two projects this year. Tell your youth group that they can come and help us, or get your adult Sunday School classes to volunteer for a day.

I have enclosed your giving record for the year. Without your gifts, we would not be able to continue this wonderful ministry. May God richly bless you in 2011! To God be the glory for the things He has done and continues to do!
