
LOOKING BACK | LOOKING AHEAD Supporters Update 2024

Whether we are repairing a leaky pipe or sharing the gospel with someone, we always represent Christ and everything we do is worthy of doing for His glory.

In the spirit of those verses and thoughts we are excited about what God has in store for the coming year. We have been praying for some time that God would open a door of opportunity



to minister in some way to our surrounding community. We are thrilled to let you know that God has answered that prayer. Joyce George (co-founder and office manager) and Valerie Gay (accounts receivable) have stepped up and will be offering English classes on Sunday afternoons in the Family Center here at Siloam. We will be able to incorporate the Gospel into every lesson offered and already have several interested in the course.

We have not forgotten about the missionaries that call this place home. As many of you are aware we completed our newest house in 2022 and this last year we began the process of updating several of the existing homes. We were able to do some upgrades to one of the basement apartments and replaced the downstairs flooring in one of our larger homes. This year we will be making some safety improvements to the deck on one unit, upgrading the downstairs apartments with some usable outdoor space on their porches, and updating the carpet, paint, and fixtures in the upstairs of one of our larger homes. We will also be replacing two roofs and the siding on two of the two-story homes.

Why do we share this with you? One, so you can pray. We cannot put into words how much we are looking forward to being able to share the Gospel each week with our community. Two, so you can share the need. Many of these updates are critical to the preservation of the houses here at Siloam but are outside the normal annual maintenance budget. So, just as we've raised funds in the past for new homes, we need to raise funds each year for the next few years to be able to update and refresh the existing homes.

Again, we thank you for your faithful support of the ministry here and ask that you prayerfully consider not only continuing to partner with us through your existing giving, but consider increasing your giving to help meet these additional needs.
