Joyce and I have been praying diligently that God would provide a way for us to get the road on the property done. We asked God to provide this before the end of January -- and HE DID!!

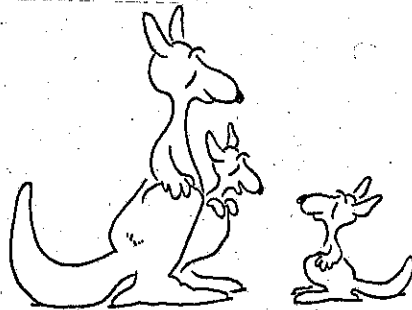

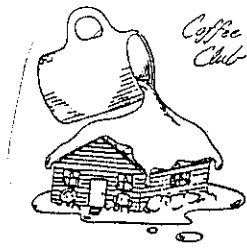
Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,
