Siloam Missionary Homes has about \$5,000 to start and will be will start building September 18, 1993, Lord willing. Thank you so much for all your help both through prayers and your financial support. "Our God shall supply all our needs according to His riches in Christ Jesus." Do you believe that? I do with all my heart. Be a part of this next step and ask God what He wants you to do. Look at this picture - can you see the home nestled in the trees?.....

us. We want to say thank you to those of you who have been with us for a while already, because you have been so faithful! We want to welcome the following new members:

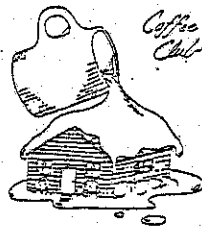

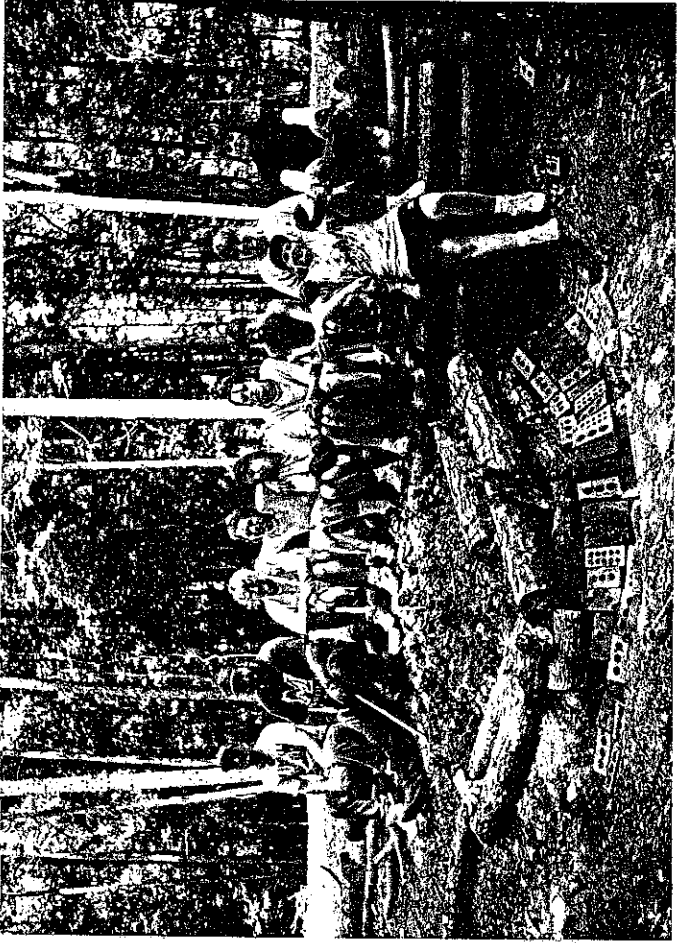


Dear Coffee Club Members,

The girls are ready to start back to school. Rachel has already started volleyball practice. In fact, I had to take her to the doctor last evening because (the serious sports person that she is) she

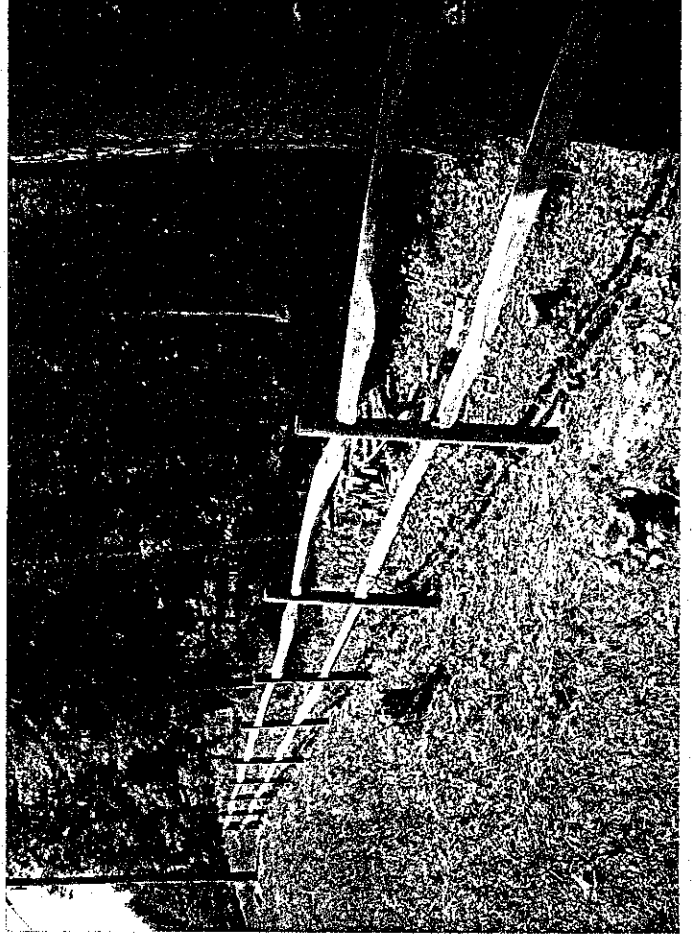


THANKS IRONS TEENS!
