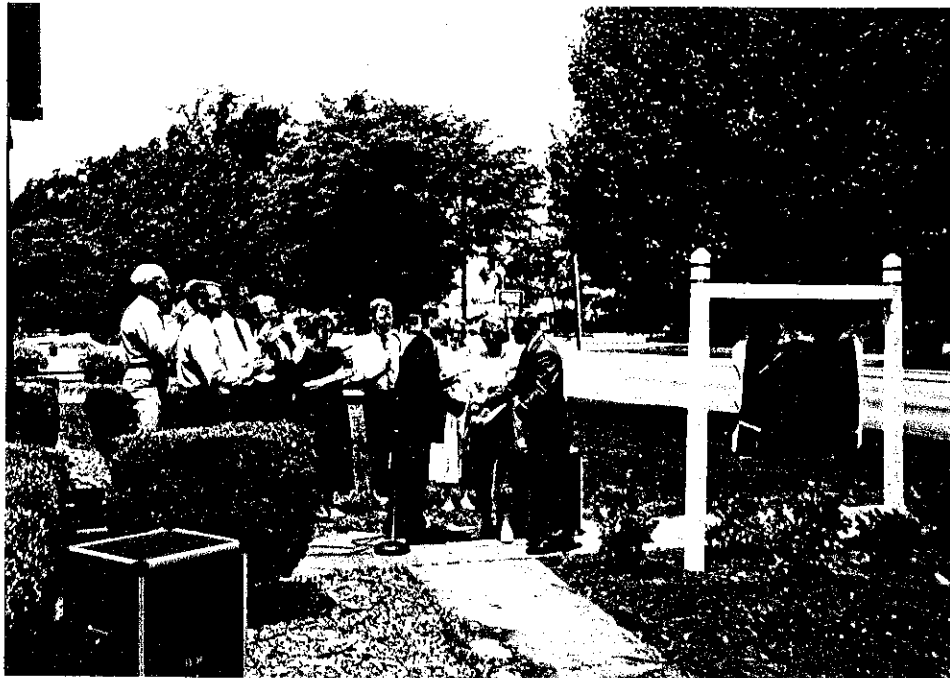
## SILOAM MISSIONARY INN DEDICATION

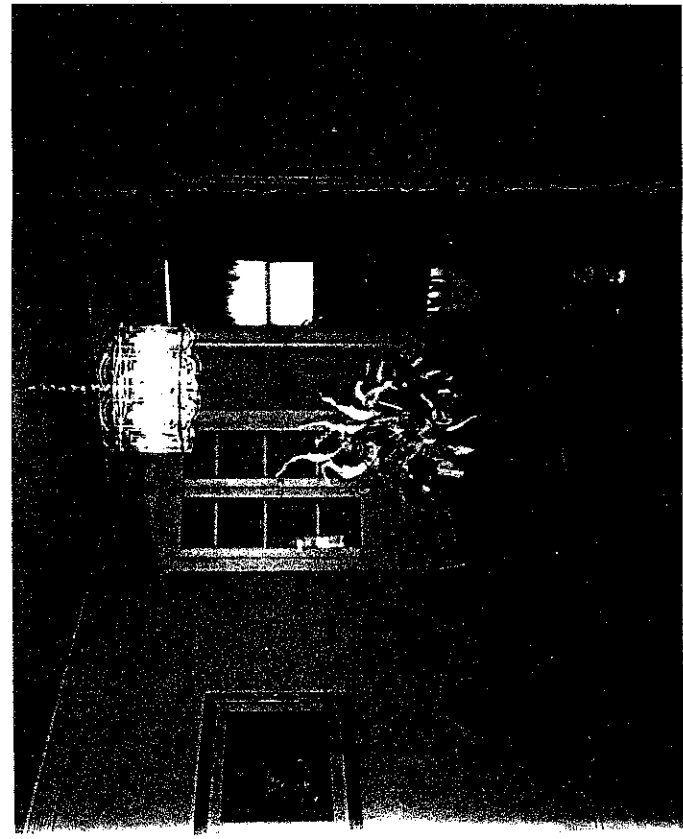

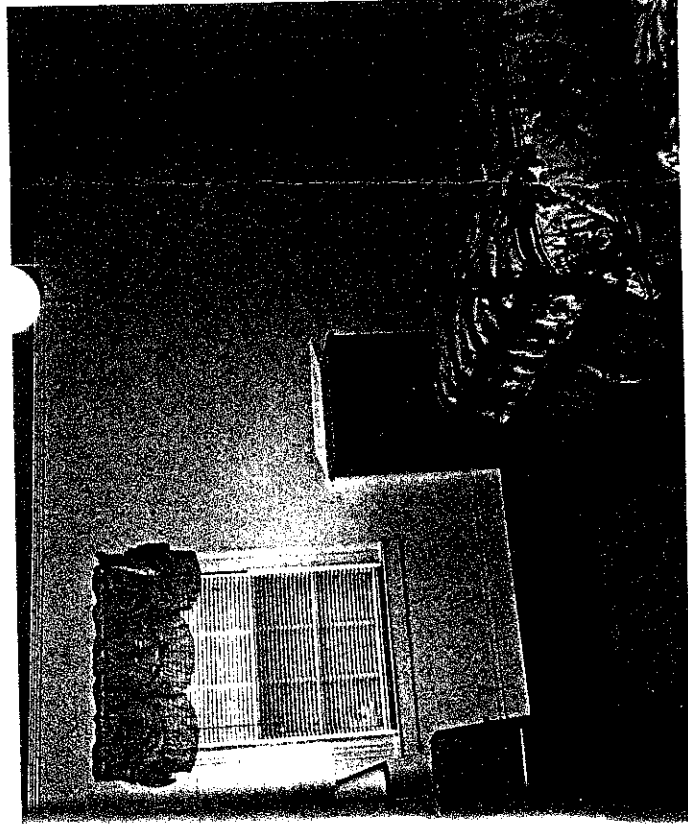

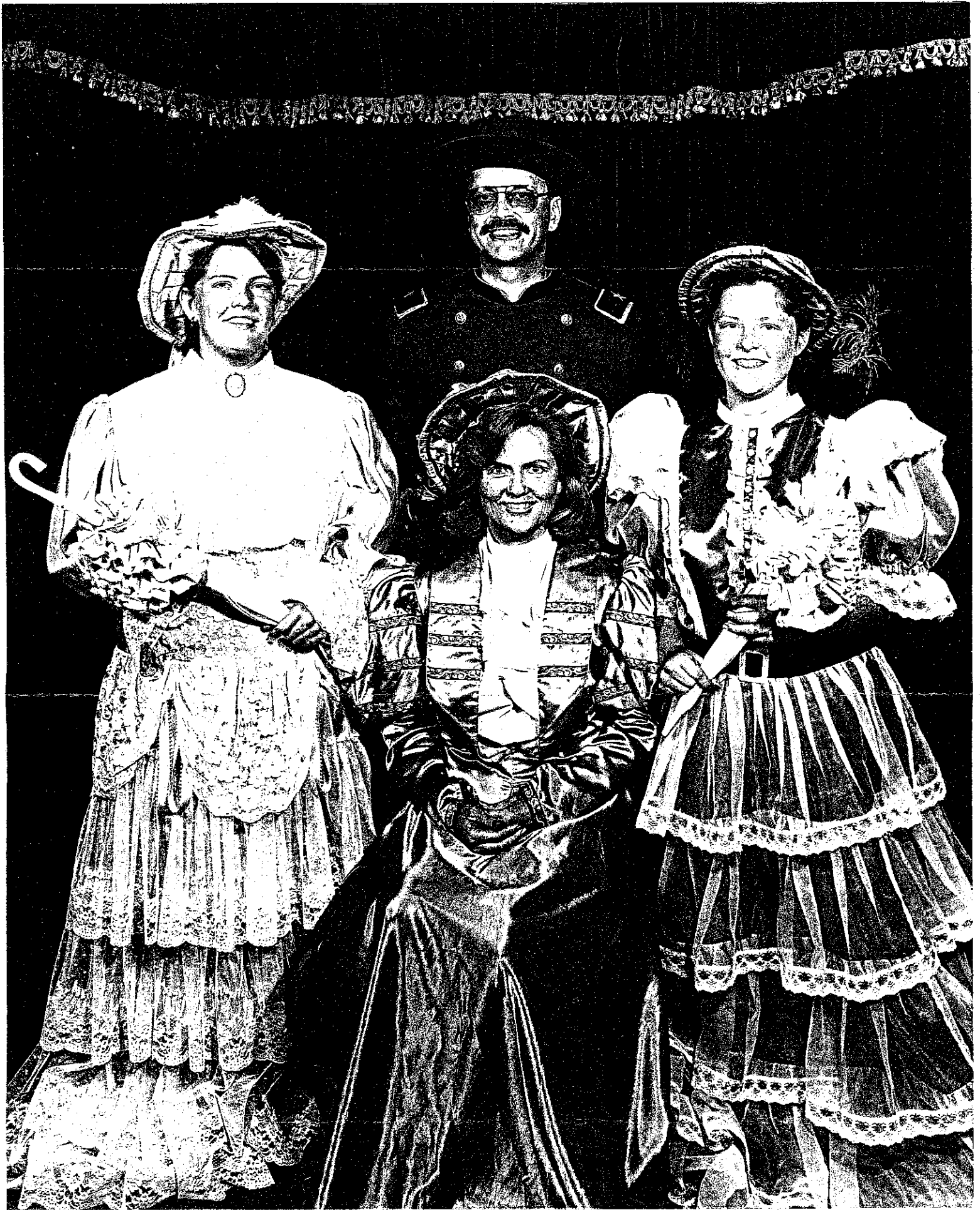
