Please pray for us here at Siloam. The need is once again for more housing. Currently, we are booked and have people on a waiting list.

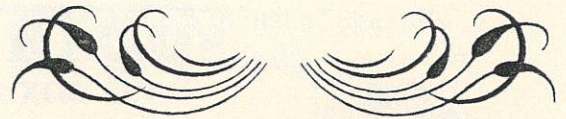
