We hope you will find God calling you to help in a way that brings you joy.

VOLUNTEERING ONSITE

Green Thumb: We have a green house and office plants that need attention. If you're good with plants and want to get your hands dirty, this might be for you.

Fashionista: Okay, so it's not Paris but we have a clothing boutique full of donated clothing for the missionaries. We need someone who likes working with clothing to sort, organize, and display the clothing to provide the missionaries with a nice place to get clothes. The boutique is called The Treasure Chest.

Organize a Group Visit to Siloam: The best way to see and understand what we do is to bring a group out for lunch and a tour!

Community Buildings: Organizing, cleaning and stocking food in Dad's Country Store or cleaning and organizing toys in the Mingo building are also an option.

Cooking and Baking: We occasionally need someone to cook or bake for a group. Whether it's a missionary fellowship, a church group visiting to learn about Siloam or a work group here to do a project, your culinary skills would be appreciated.

Newsletter Volunteer: Four times per year we need a few folks to come out and help us prepare a mailing. This involves placing labels, sometimes stuffing envelopes, etc.

Cleaning: If you enjoy cleaning and want to help, let us know.

Organize a Work Team: Come out and work on a project for us. This would usually be landscaping or construction. It might involve painting.

Groundskeeping Help: Do you enjoy landscaping work? Do you like to rake, shovel, blow leaves, mow lawns, split wood, etc? We can use extra hands in these areas throughout the year.

Babysitting: Occasionally we have a missionary family that might need a babysitter.

VOLUNTEERING FROM HOME

Organize a Drive: Collect items we need with your church or any group you are involved in.

Food: We regularly accept donations of food for the missionaries. These go into Dad's Country Store which is like a huge pantry in a cute old-timey country store. There are freezers and a refrigerator. Everything in the store is free to the missionaries.

Clothing: Sometimes we need clothing donated to the Treasure Chest.

Pillows, Towels or Bed Linens: Occasionally we need these to replace worn out ones in the homes.

Share What We Do!!: Share with your community about the work we do at Siloam and how they might help support our mission financially. If you or your church support any missionaries, please tell them about this wonderful resource available to them.

Skill Share: Do you have a hobby or skill like refinishing furniture, woodworking, sewing, etc? We might be able to use those skills to make the homes better.

Volunteer Coordinator: Do you enjoy people and want to help recruit, retain, and schedule volunteers?

Resource Coordinator: If seeking out resources is your thing, this might be for you.

Pray: Pray for Siloam and the missionaries who come here, however you feel called to pray.

Adopt a Home: Would you like to be a part of directly encouraging a missionary and also get to know them and their ministry better? Consider adopting a home and being part of the welcome process every time a missionary family moves into that home. When a missionary arrives we put together a gift basket for them of things they will need when they first settle into their home. We would also love to include gift cards and other special welcome gifts, which you could help provide. We would encourage you to invite them to your church's special services and events and maybe even come to the property and have a picnic lunch or dinner with them.
